L1 was identified as M/s NJR Constructions ltd, Hyderabad. Contract time period: 08 Months. The value of the contract was Rs. 23,52,93,962.70. Due to Covid and lockdown, on Contractor's request, the LOA for the said work was issued on 30.12.2020 vide LOA No. IIITS/Works/20201202, Dt. 30.12. 2020. M/s CUBE was engaged in Mar 2021, to act as PMC, on behalf of IIIT Sri City.
